Parking

COVID-19 Guidance

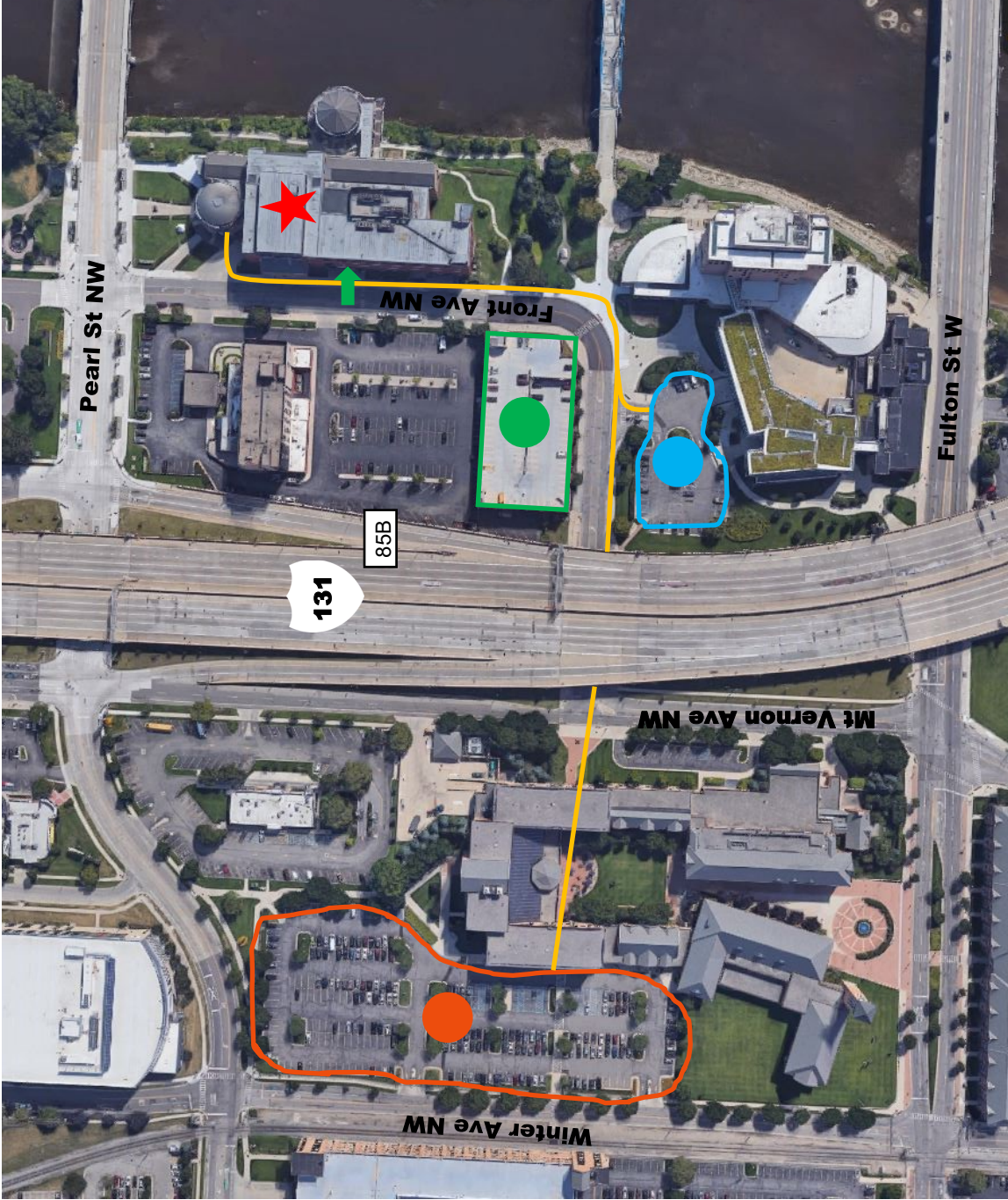
The GRPM Continues to Keep Your Health in Mind and is Ensuring a Low Risk Environment During Your Visit:

GRPM is accessible for all visitors with ramps at the museum's entrance and elevators to all floors. Sensory tool kits, equipped with noise-canceling headphones, fidget tools, verbal cue cards, and weighted lap pads, are also available to check out from the front desk for visitors of all ages. The museum also has a Quiet Room for anyone who needs a private area to be away from crowds. This family friendly, low sensory space is a great resource for breastfeeding mothers, individuals or families with special sensory needs, those in need of an adult changing area and more. The Grand Rapids Public Museum is located in the heart of downtown Grand Rapids, on the west bank of the Grand River at [272 Pearl Street NW](#) [Grand Rapids, MI 49504](#)

From US 131, take exit 85B, Pearl Street. The Museum is one block east at the corner of Pearl & Front Street.

From I-196, take exit 77C (Ottawa Ave/Downtown) proceed south to Pearl St. and turn right. The Museum is located across the bridge on the left side.
